Senior citizens in Kent County, Delaware have been served through the Senior Center Program as well as the Shopping Program operated by Harvest Years Senior Center. We will continue to stay open to home deliver lunches to you, to help out during the COVID-19 outbreak, grocery shop for you and if you are 60 and older we will transport you to and from your healthcare medical appointments. Please call us at 302 698-4285 for more information. Say all of that, this is what we now know.

Governor Carney issued the <u>thirteenth modification</u> to his State of Emergency declaration, which requires Delawareans to wear face coverings in public settings including in grocery stores, convenience stores, pharmacies, doctor's offices, and on public transportation.

Governor Carney's order does not require children aged 12 or younger to wear a face mask covering. Any child 2 years-old or younger <u>must not</u> wear a face covering, due to the risk of suffocation.

Delaware continues to face a serious situation. Delawareans should stay home unless it is absolutely necessary to go out for essential work or essential items. Don't go out in public unnecessarily. You will only increase your risk - and the risk to your family, friends, and neighbors.

Guidelines for face coverings:

- Make sure you can breathe
- Wear it in public settings where social distancing is difficult to maintain
- Make sure it covers your nose and mouth
- Wash after each use, or at least once a day




