MEDICARE FRAUD REPORT

March 2025

The Delaware Senior Medicare Patrol educates Medicare beneficiaries about fraud and abuse, and how to prevent, detect, and report it.

Hospice Fraud

Did someone reach out and offer free, in-home perks like cooking and cleaning in exchange for your Medicare number? Don't give it. That could be a scammer trying to commit hospice fraud. Scammers are targeting older adults — with calls, texts, emails, fake ads, and even door-to-door visits — claiming they'll set you up with services like free cooking, cleaning, and home health care. What they likely won't tell you is how: They want to <u>commit fraud</u> by signing you up for Medicare hospice — that's right, hospice — care. Then, they can bill Medicare for all kinds of services in your name.

Here's what to know: Hospice care is a specialized service, often done at home, for people with a terminal illness approaching the end of life. Only your doctor can certify that you're eligible for hospice (meaning your life expectancy is 6 months or less). If you're signed up for hospice and don't need it, this could affect your Medicare coverage in the future. Anyone who tells you differently is a scammer.

Here are some ways to avoid hospice scams:

- Never give your Medicare number to someone offering "free" services like housekeeping or cooking. Medicare doesn't offer free services like that.
- Never agree to sign up for hospice care in exchange for perks or gifts like money, gift cards, or groceries.
- Know that Medicare will never come to your home to sign you up for services. If someone comes to your door, says they're from Medicare, and tries to get you to sign up for services, they're lying. Don't give them any information.



If you think you've spotted or experienced hospice fraud, report it as soon as possible. Call 1-800-MEDICARE or reach out to us for help. -- by Kira Krown, Federal Trade Commission

25 Canadian Nationals Charged in "Grandparent Scam"

On February 20, 2025, a federal grand jury returned an indictment charging 25 Canadian nationals with participation in a "Grandparent Scam" that defrauded elderly individuals in Vermont and more than 40 other states. During phone calls, defendants falsely claimed to be an elderly victim's relative, typically a grandchild, who had been arrested following a car crash and needed money for "bail." Other defendants posed as an "attorney" representing the elderly victim's relative. Elderly victims were often told that there was a "gag order" in place to prevent the elderly victim from telling anyone about their family member's supposed arrest. Elderly victims were convinced to provide bail money to an individual falsely posing as a bail bondsman, who would come to the elderly victim's home to collect the money.

Monthly Recipe - Springtime Salad

Asparagus, Mandarin Orange, Chicken, and Rice

Ingredients: For the Vinaigrette:

- 2 Tbs. Extra Virgin Olive Oil
- 2 Tbs. Rice Vinegar
- 3 Tbs. Mandarin Orange Juice (reserved from oranges)
- 1 Tbs. Soy Sauce, reduced sodium

For The Salad:

- 3 1/2 Cups Fresh Asparagus (trimmed)
- 2 Cans (22 ozs. each) Mandarin Oranges, Drained Reserve Juice
- 12 Ounces Cooked Chicken Breast (cut into chunks)
- 3 Cups Cooked Instant Brown Rice

Directions:

- 1. In a small bowl, whisk together vinaigrette ingredients, set aside.
- 2. Cook Rice according to Package. Directions.
- 3. Place whole trimmed asparagus in a large skillet with 1 1/2" water.
- 4. Bring to a boil, reduce heat and simmer, uncovered for 2-5 minutes.
- 5. Rinse with cold water and cut into 1" pieces.
- 6. In a medium size bowl, toss all ingredients.




