The Strawberry Moon June 21, 2024



The sixth full moon of 2024, also know as the **"Strawberry Moon"** made a stunning appearance in the evening skies on Friday, June 21st and signaled a change in the seasons.

It coincided with the beginning of astronomical summer north of the equator and the start of winter south of the equator, but also marked a rare **"major lunar standstill"** not seen since 2006.

The latest at night to rise of the year in the northern hemisphere, the **"Strawberry Moon"** is always the lowest hanging full moon. That's because it mirrors the sun's position; when the sun is at its highest, the full moon-which is opposite the sun-will be at its lowest. In practice, that means it never gets very high in the sky.

However, this year that was even more extreme because of the once-every 18.6 years major lunar standstill. When the tilts of the moon and Earth are at their maximum, the moon rises and sets at the furthest points on its range on the horizon.

### **Property Fraud Alert**

Anyone who follows the news has seen some type of identity theft cyber crime, whether your bank account, credit card, or some other theft of your personal information. Though not nearly to the extent some aggressive ads on TV and radio would have us believe, identity theft involving property can and does happen, leaving a wake of destruction for individuals who fall prey to it. Through the Kent County Recorder of Deeds Eugenia Thornton and her office, Kent County offers FREE Property Faud Alert emails that offer total transparency in government. When you register, you will be notified if there are unauthorized transaction made in your name regarding your deed. If you register, you will find out when the Deeds office records legitimate transactions in any of the names you have registered. Some examples are: a) There has been a legal change of ownership. b) If liens are placed or removed. c) When mortgages are made or are satisfied. d) If you jointly own property with others, not your spouse, register for this software and learn if one of the co-owners is encumbering the property. e) Absentee landlords can find out if the HOA or the county has put a lien on a home that the management company or renter is not maintaining the property. f) If a senior has sold their property to a caregiver when relatives exist (Elder Abuse is a crime). A house cannot be stolen from its rightful owners. Identity theft involving mortgages, vacant houses, titles, etc. is a crime. The damage done to the seller relates to credit repair, cloudy titles, time spent and possible attorney fees. The damage done to the buyer is the loss of money used to buy the property, or down payments and closing costs, and the loss of money used to fix up a property that in almost all cases will not be retained in their name. This is significant damage! In a few minutes, citizens can be better protected against title theft and be up to the minute on any legitimate transactions that occur in their name on the property indexed to them. IM-PORTANT! An alert does not mean illegal or unauthorized activity. This is an alert system, not a prevention system. No one can prevent cybercrime. Your best defense is to learn about it quickly to reduce damage and legal fees Find out how to register for our FREE property transaction software by requesting our "Register for Free Property Transaction Softwareâ€□ Be alerted of both legitimate and illegitimate transactions in your name. 

Q. What can/cannot be purchased with SNAP benefits? A. Households CAN use SNAP benefits to buy: Breads, cereals, fruits & vegetables, dairy products, meats, fish, poultry, seeds & plants which produce food for the household to eat. Households CANNOT use SNAP benefits to buy: Beer, wine, liquor, cigarettes or tobacco; or any non-food items such as: Pet foods, soaps, paper products, or household supplies. Soft drinks, candy, cookies, snack crackers & ice cream are eligible. Energy drinks with nutrition facts are eligible; without supplement facts are not eligible.
