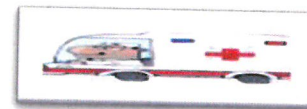
Health Care Transport Program

Seniors Beware: A Harvest Years senior was recently taken advantage of by a dishonest handyman. He claimed to have bought materials, but never did! He claimed to have paid for and to have installed a product, but did not. **Red flags** to watch out for are as follows:

1. Not producing receipts, no matter how small or big the items or job.
2. Making excuses for why the job isn't done or why items have not been purchased or why materials have not been purchased or why materials have not arrived.
3. Not having credentials or recommendations.

In this situation, most of a **prepaid**, very large sum of money was returned, but only after police involvement and 5 weeks of waiting and unfulfilled promises. This kind of activity is considered elder abuse and is emotionally unsettling.

If you feel you are or have been taken advantage of, report the incident to your local police station. To stop this from happening again, the **victim** reported the actions to the Delaware Dep't of Justice, The Delaware Attorney General Office, Dep't of Aging, AARP, Elder Fraud & others.

Keeping detailed records and all documentation such as text messages, e-mails and notes from phone calls can be helpful to police in case they are needed to prove your case in court and/or to protect yourself.

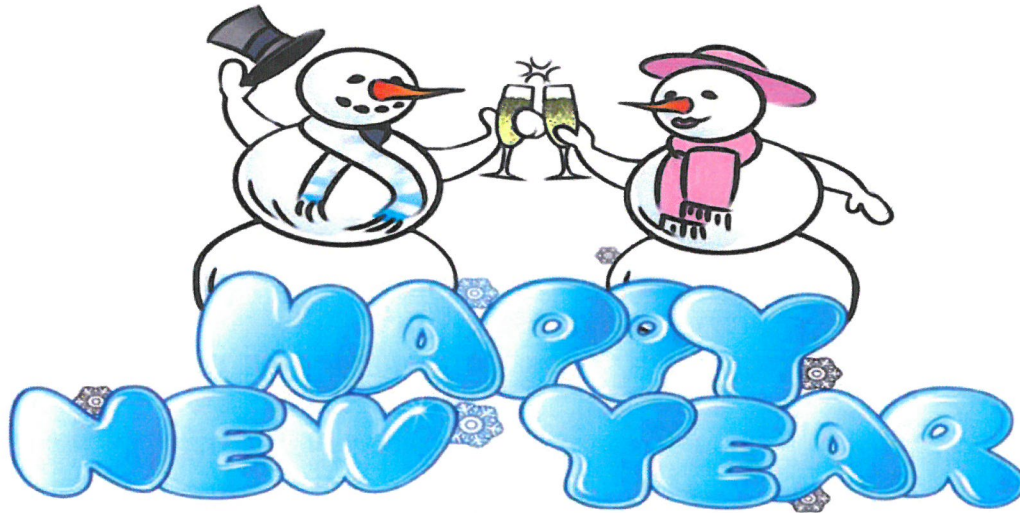

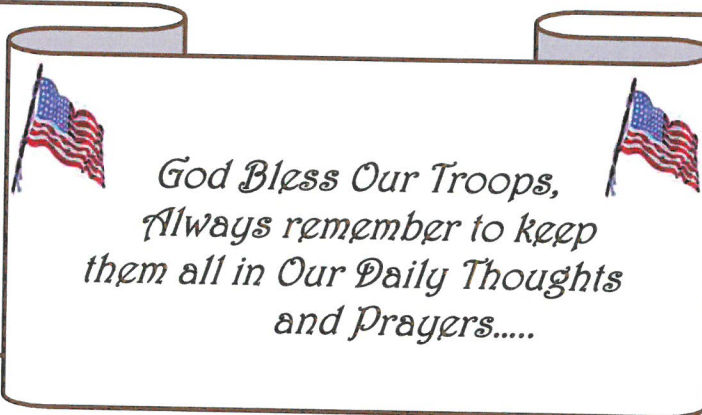
