

We have not made a decision on when this will be done and what adjustments this will require us to make in our scheduled activities We will of course keep you informed of such changes in a timely manner. Once that work is completed we will consider the replacement of the chairs in that room

In recent months, we have expanded our activity opportunities to include Bingo, Spring and Fall Outdoor Picnics, Men's and Women's Clubs for which we are hoping for more of you to join. Generating ideas like these is the main reason the Board holds twice-a-year Saturday workshops to provide us the opportunity to engage in long term planning. The Board is always open to any suggestions or ideas about our offerings on the facility our members may have.

Recipe of the Month - Peanut Butter Puffs

1 cup all-purpose flour, plus extra for dusting.

1 egg yolk

1/4 cup superfine sugar

Pinch of salt

- 7 Tbsp butter, softened
- 2 Tbsp crunchy peanut butter Confectioners' sugar for dusting
- 1.Preheat oven to 350*F. Kneed all of the ingredients for the dough together thoroughly.
- 2.Making sure that your hands are cool, cover them in a light coating of flour, then pull off walnut-sized pieces of dough and roll them into balls. Place the balls of dough on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper, leaving a space between them, and press them flat with the back of a fork.
- 3.Place on the middle rack of the oven and bake for approx. 10 minutes, or until golden brown. Let cool on a wire rack, then dust with confectioners' sugar. (Makes 35)
