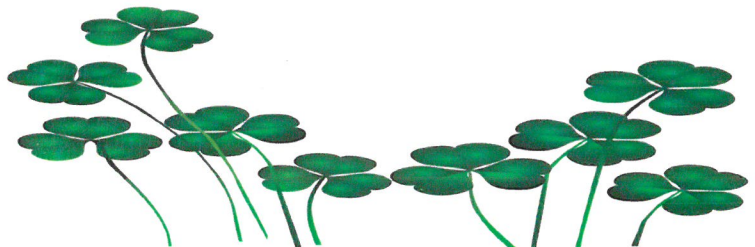

*Spring Is  
In The Air  
March 20,  
2026*

The first day of spring (March equinox or vernal equinox) is when the sun shines directly on the celestial equator passing from south to north and the length of day and night are almost the same. This is referred to as astronomical spring or the March equinox or vernal equinox.

Astronomical spring starts at different times around the planet because of the different time zones as related to Coordinated Universal Time (UTC, same as Greenwich Mean Time based on the Royal Observatory in Greenwich, London [1]). For countries located west of UTC your spring will start earlier than countries located east of UTC.

## Director's Report

### MARCH 2026



As we transition from this long, cold winter into spring we want you to consider some initiatives the Board of Directors is taking. A year ago, we sought interest in creating a men's club. Unfortunately, there was very little interest. Several guys who are Directors or staff members have met occasionally for breakfast. We are going to try to expand the group by having a men's breakfast at the center on Friday, April 17th. This will be open to dues paying male members only for a nominal fee of \$8.00. If interested, indicate by signing the sign-in sheet on the front desk by Monday, April 3th.

The Board believes that as a non-profit organization serving a vital mission in our community matters. Working with Dan Rigby, in charge of community relations for the Caesar Rodney school district, we want to involve interested center members in a peer mentoring program with the school district. You would serve as **Reading Buddies**, reading one-on-one with a student for thirty minutes once a week. You will be provided guidance on what to do and we want to see if we can get this program off the ground in April and May. Again, there will be a sign-up sheet on the front desk for those interested. At least two members of the Board are eager to participate.

Working through Mr. Rigley and the guidance department at CR, we are establishing an Annual \$2,000 scholarship to be awarded a graduating CR senior who plans to pursue a career path related to programs for the elderly. Interested applicants will be asked to write an essay explaining why they wish to follow such a goal and to sit for an interview by our Board of Directors. The \$2,000 will be sent to the recipient's college or university upon the successful completion of their first semester.

In another effort to improve communication with our members, the Directors will be wearing name badges at the center, easily spotted by the bright orange lanyards holding the badges. This gives you the opportunity to ask questions about what is going on at the center. Do not hesitate to thank them as well for the time and effort they put into improving the center and its numerous programs and activities.

As always, we'll see you around the center.

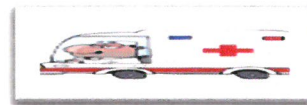
Health Care Transport Program

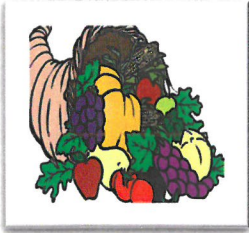

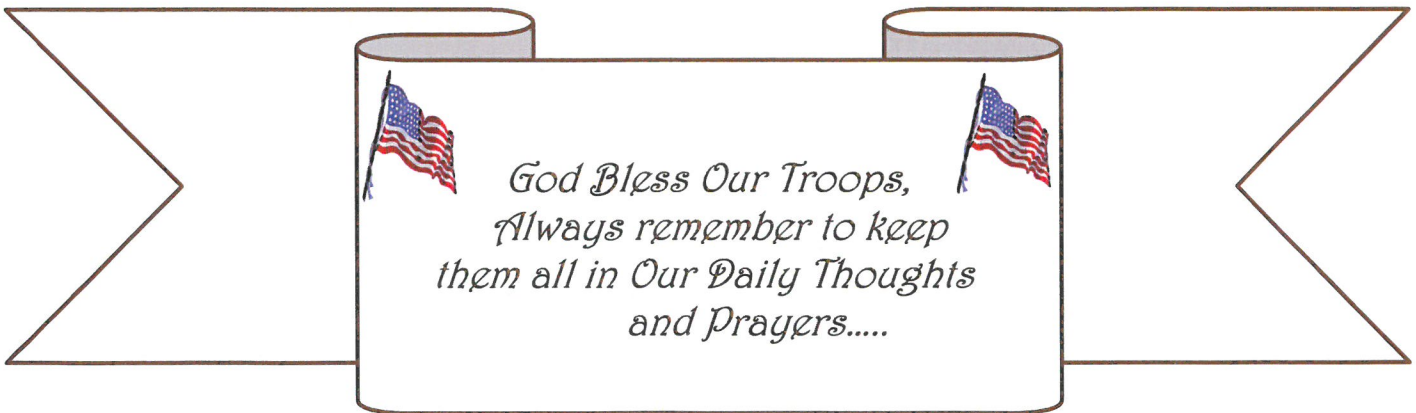
