DIRECTOR'S REPORT MAY, 2025

We want to update you on planned improvements to the center. The great room is in need of some repairs and re-painting. There are a couple of cracks in the wall behind the coffee machine. We recently had those examined by an expert in the field who informed us that these are the result of the normal settling of an aging building and not indicative of any structural issues. We are now able to proceed to schedule the work. We will, of course, keep you aware of the timing and any adjustments we will need to make to our normal scheduled activities.

We also plan to have a new storage shed built on our back property. The one that already exists is quite crowded with tables, grills, fold-up tents, etc. in addition to paper products used by the kitchen. A second shed will enable us to keep the paper products in the original shed separate from the rest. This will allow us to buy these items in bulk saving the center money while also making it easier for staff members to get to those materials when they need to. Moving the outside equipment from one shed to another will be a Men's Club activity. We thank staff member Dave Lewis for this sensible suggestion.

The Board encourages center members to consider the worth of the various trips we offer. We have faced challenges since the pandemic in attracting enough participants to make some trips, especially those lasting more than a day, financially feasible. One trip we had to cancel was a trip to Long Island, New York. We are considering trying again with a shorter excursion of 3 days and two nights. This would mean less time away from home and hopefully, a substantial reduction in cost. If you think you might be interested in this, please let our Activities Director, Diane Amoroso, know.

May is a very busy month at HYSC. We will have our Annual Spring Outdoor Picnic on May 16th. The next day, Saturday, May 17th we will host participants in a major East Coast car show for lunch. And on May 23rd we will conduct out Annual Memorial Day Tribute to our valued veterans. We strongly encourage you to join us in this moving acknowledgement of those who have done so much for their country. As the bridge sign outside Dover Air Force Base says "ALL GAVE SOME. SOME GAVE ALL".

RECIPE OF THE MONTH - Lemon Pasta

2 Tbsp. Olive Oil 2 Tbsp. unsalted butter 4 Garlic Cloves, thinly sliced 1/4 tsp. Red Pepper Flakes 1 lb. Uncooked Spaghetti 2 tsp. Kosher Salt 1/2 Cup grated Parmesan Cheese, plus more for serving 2 Tbsp. Fresh Lemon Zest 1/4 Cup Fresh Lemon Juice 1/4 Cup Chopped Fresh Basil, plus more for serving Sprinkle Freshly ground black pepper for serving

1. Heat a large pot over medium heat; add the oil & butter. Allow the butter to foam, then add the garlic & red pepper flakes. Cook until fragrant, 1 minute.

2. Add the pasta, 6 cups of water, and salt to the pot and bring to a simmer. Reduce the heat to medium -low and continue simmering for 8 - 10 minutes, until pasta is al dente.

3. Remove from the heat and stir in the parmesan, lemon zest, lemon juice, pepper & basil.
