

# October Is Breast Cancer Awareness Month



Breast Cancer Awareness Month (BCAM), also referred to in the United States as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month (NBCAM), is an annual international health campaign organized by major <u>breast cancer</u> charities every October to increase <u>awareness of the disease</u> and <u>raise funds</u> for research into its cause, prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and cure.

Observances of the event have faced criticism for corporate involvement by drug companies, as well as instances of <u>pinkwashing</u> associated with the events.

History: White House illuminated pink in honor of National Breast Cancer Awareness Month in 2017



NBCAM was founded in 1985 in partnership between the <u>American Cancer Society</u> and the pharmaceutical division of <u>Imperial Chemical Industries</u> (now part of <u>AstraZeneca</u>, producer of several anti-breast cancer drugs). The aim of the NBCAM from the start has been to promote mammography as the most effective weapon in the fight against breast cancer.

In 1993 Evelyn Lauder, Senior Corporate Vice President of the Estée Lauder Companies, founded the Breast Cancer Research Foundation and established the pink ribbon as its symbol, though this was not the first time the ribbon was used to symbolize breast cancer: A 68-year-old California woman named Charlotte Haley, whose sister, daughter, and granddaughter had breast cancer, had distributed peach-color ribbons to call attention to what she perceived as inadequate funding for research. In the fall of 1991, the Susan G. Komen Foundation handed out pink ribbons to participants in its New York City race for breast cancer survivors.

In 2010, <u>Delta Air Lines</u> painted N845MH, a <u>Boeing 767</u>-432ER in "Breast Cancer Research Foundation" special colors. In September 2015, a newer version of the livery was repainted on the same plane.
