

AUGUST 2023 REPORT

Noise Complaints

Noise complaints are one of my biggest concerns here in Kent County. I am sure it happens everywhere, but it seems like people choose to stay or move to Kent County because of our slower lifestyle, easy living, lower taxes, and avoiding the urban life.

But when you are confronted with unwanted noise, especially in the middle of the night or early morning, it can make you reconsider your choices. I am not talking about those who choose to live in the flight path of the great C-5 or C-17 airplanes that land at Dover Air Force Base, or next to the few railroad lines throughout the County. Both have been here for many decades. I am referring to the homeowner with a sound system that offends the whole community, or want to run their circular saw at 6:00am to get a jump on that shed project, needs to mow before the rain starts at 7:00am, or the neighbor's dog barking at shadows until 2:00am.

If you live in the incorporated limits of any town in Kent County, most have some type of noise ordinance. Every town is different, but your town council or local police would likely respond. Just remember that responding to a noise issue is very low on the response scale for officers who are overworked and have the responsibility for protecting life and safety.

If you live in the unincorporated areas of Kent County, first, talk to your neighbor to see if they are willing to tone it down or change the time of their offense. This will not always work, and unfortunately, it sometimes leads to animosity between neighbors. If you have an HOA with bylaws that address noise, you may have to engage with them to intervene, or use your Property Management Company, if you have one. If none of those work, your only option is to contact the Kent County Code Enforcement Office to file a complaint. You need to provide the address, what times the noise is occurring, and what the noise is. You could call 9-1-1, but do not expect an immediate response from Kent County Code Enforcement. Kent County does not have 24-hour Code Enforcement, unless it is a life/safety issue, such as a vehicle accident involving a structure. I know that noise can be annoying, especially to the night shift worker who is trying to sleep during the day, so please don't think I don't understand.

If the offense is reoccurring, Kent County will send a Code Enforcement Officer to investigate. If the investigator can experience it, a citation could be issued. If it progresses to the court system, there are requirements for gathering decibel evidence of ambient noise when the offense is not occurring and when it is occurring to identify the difference. It is not an easy offense to litigate.

Hopefully, you will have a courteous neighbor, who will simply curb their sound. Likewise, if you are reading this and you ARE the offender, please consider your neighbors.


<u>Health Care Transport</u> Program
