WHO ARE WE?

Harvest Years Senior Center, Inc. has proudly carried out it's service motto of "Seniors Helping Seniors" for the past 46 years. Senior Citizens in Kent County Delaware have been served through the Senior Center Program as well as the Shopping Program, and our third service program, Health Care Transportation all operated by Harvest Years Senior Center.

Harvest Years Senior Center Program serves a current active member group of 620+ with a comprehensive monthly calendar of educational, recreational, social and wellness activities both on and off site. A hot nutritious, noon-time meal is prepared on-site and served restaurant style or grab and Go.

The <u>Shopping Program</u> currently serves 130 eligible Kent County seniors with their grocery shopping needs. Concurrent trips can also be made to the pharmacy, bank and post office. The <u>Shopping Program supports Senior Independent Living</u>. Additional to this service we added the Healthcare transportation service.
