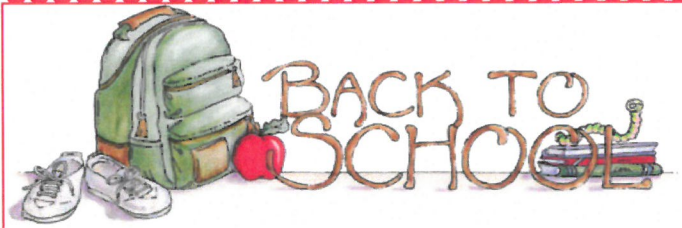
Member Bingo is on **Friday, September 13th at 12:30 PM**. We have lots of prizes to give away. Come in early for lunch before Bingo begins.

SEPTEMBER 2024 REPORT

Tax Bills

Tax bills from Kent County have been sent out. For a couple of years, I have been sharing that County Taxes would increase for 1/3, decrease for 1/3, and stay roughly the same for 1/3 of parcels. Nobody likes a tax increase. The Kent County government is one of the most efficient governments in Delaware and Levy Court Commissioners are very aware that it is YOUR money.

Kent County Commissioners set the tax rate to \$.00572, which is a decrease of about 84% of the previous tax rate of \$.0360. This decrease was necessary to compensate for the higher property valuations. With that reduced rate, my statement was true for County Taxes and followed the pattern described above. If you have any questions, or you don't see your tax bill because it goes to your mortgage company, all information is available on the county website, <https://kcpms.kentcountyde.gov/>.

School Taxes are a different animal. School Tax Rates were set by School Boards of Education and District Finance Directors. Kent County has absolutely no control over the setting of tax rates by School Boards. If you take nothing else from this article, please take this: Kent County Levy Court did not raise your school taxes.

There are only a few ways that School taxes can be raised. One is through a referendum, which is voted on by the residents in their school districts. Another way is after a reassessment, like we just had. According to Delaware State Law, School District resulting revenue must be less than 10% of the previous year's revenue. If you have questions about your school tax, I advise you to reach out to your School Board Members or your local district office.

That said, there are ways to reduce your tax burden. Kent County and the State offer discounts if you are a senior citizen (over 65) or disabled veteran. Some of these have restrictions based on income or discounts on values. Please contact the Kent County Tax Office (302-744-2341), email at TaxOffice@kentcountyde.gov, or on the County website at <https://www.kentcountyde.gov/Residents/Tax-Credits-Exemptions-Assessment>

If you are a farmer, there are additional ways to reduce or eliminate the property taxes and if you have poultry houses, the County is already depreciating their value by 20% in the first year. I advise you to check out the links above, reach out to the Kent County Farm Bureau (302-697-3183), or the Agricultural Lands Preservation Foundation (302-698-4530) to learn more about AGland Preservation or the AG Farmland Program.

Finally, if you still think that your assessment is higher than it should be based on the valuation, you can appeal to Kent County BEFORE January 31 of each year, for that year's taxes. The forms to submit an appeal are also on the Kent County website at <https://kentcountyde.gov>
