



DIRECTOR'S REPORT AUGUST 2025

Welcome to the dog days of summer. We hope you are managing to stay cool and comfortable.

On June 28th, the Board held one of it's twice a year Saturday morning workshops. Our guest was Karen Crouch, Executive Director of the Harrington Senior Center. She is an outgoing and enthusiastic supporter of programs that benefit seniors and very open to cooperating and coordinating programs with HYSC. We share our newsletters with each other and each will publish trips the other is scheduling. We have found contractors to repair and re-paint the great room, hopefully in the very near future. The second shed has been completed in the back of the center. We needed the extra room for kitchen materials and our outdoor tables, tents, grills, etc. This will make it much easier for employees to retrieve needed items in a timely fashion and the Board thanks staff member, Dave Lewis for the suggestion. We also thank men's club members Dave Lewis, Russ Steiger, Bill Burke and Tom Bones for the assistance in arranging the materials and equipment between the sheds on a hot and humid Tuesday morning.

Our Executive Director, Tom Bones recently received good news. The State has moved disbursement of senior transportation funds into the community 'grant-in-aid program'. What this means is that instead of having to wait, perhaps weeks, for re-imbursement for money we have already spent, we will get the funds up front on a regular quarterly basis. The State has also increased the funding for this and the Board thanks our State Senator, Trey Paradee, for his crucial roll in getting all this accomplished.

As you can see, the Board has been having a very busy summer and looks forward to having all the above done on behalf of our membership. As always, we'll see you around the center.





DelDot Toll and Fee Increases Coming Soon to Support Infrastructure Investments

Following the signing of the toll increase resolution by Secretary of Transportation Shante Hastings and the passage of HB 164 by the Delaware General Assembly, the Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDot) has begun work to implement the toll increases and new DMV fees. According to DelDot, these increases will provide the department with an estimated \$107 million annually in additional revenue to support the department with infrastructure statewide. The increase of toll rates include:

For Delaware E-ZPass Account Holders:

-Weekdays (two-axle): \$1.50

-Weekends (two-axle): \$4.00

FOR CASH/Non-Delaware E-ZPass Account Holders:

-Weekdays (two-axle): \$2.50

-Weekends (two-axle): \$6.00
