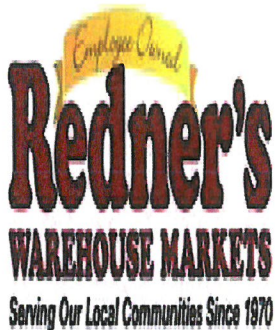

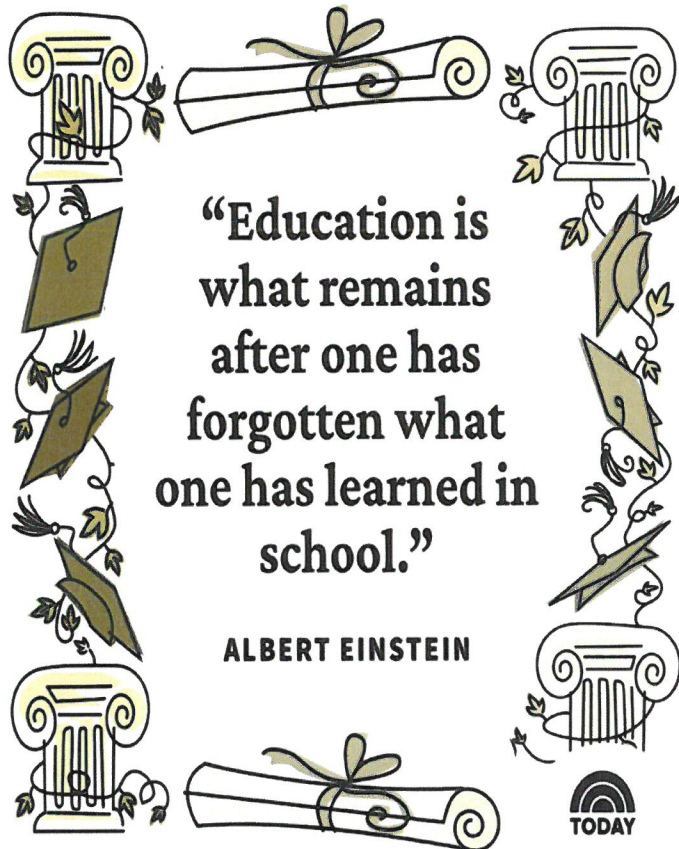

Director's Report

JUNE 2026



Welcome to **June**, the month of graduations, Father's Day and the official start of Summer. Your Board of Directors has been busy the past few weeks getting several projects up and running.

We had a breakfast for dues paying male members on April 17th. Our Executive Director, Tom Bones, made a delicious breakfast of pancakes and sausage that we enjoyed. While sharing fellowship and a few laughs, one of the guys taught the rest of us how to play and score shuffleboard which we then got to use in playing a game. We'll schedule another one in the near future with a planned menu of scrambled eggs and bacon and a discussion of other activities we would like to engage in. Watch for coming information about a date on the message board in front of the center.

In the last week of April, four volunteers from the center met at Reilly Brown Elementary School with Dan Rigby, Director of Community Relations for the Caesar Rodney School District, Dr. Ashlee Upp, Principal of Reilly Brown and Courtney Horn, activities liaison teacher. We created a new program, we are calling Reilly Brown Reading Buddies. Whereby, our volunteers spend a half an hour a week reading one-on-one with a student at the school. The Board recognizes and thanks the volunteers; Nancy Grebe, Patty Hartmannsgruber, Betty Martin and Jack Walters. All agree that the rewards of doing this far outweighs the expenditure of time. Board President, Jack Walters will represent HYSC when Hayden is recognized at CR's Awards Night Program on June 4th. We thank CRHS counselor Sarah Borja for her help in establishing this scholarship.
