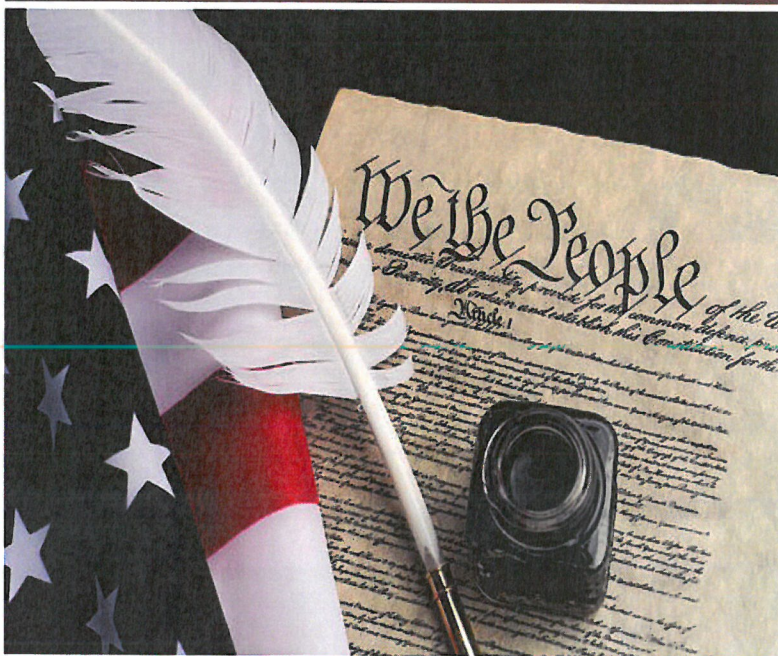

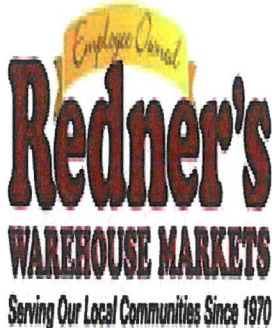

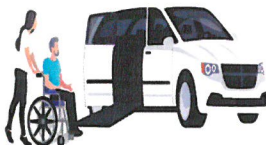

There will be a **\$3.00 'Trip Donation'** payable by cash or check. We will not go into Sussex County or New Castle County due to cost.

All cancellations must be called in 48 hours in advance.

FYI: Due to liability issues, we will require / request you to have a caregiver travel with you if you are using a wheelchair or have cognitive difficulties.

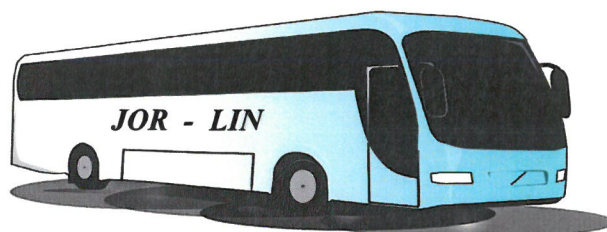

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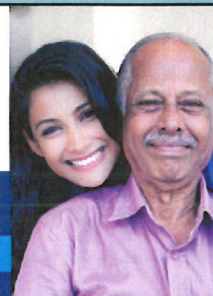

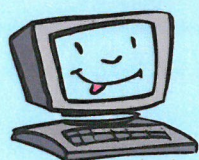
