Early Black Inventors Cooked Up Kitchen Wonders

In the 1800's over 50 labor saving kitchen devices were developed by black inventors. These are just a few.

The Tuskegee Airmen

The **Tuskegee Airmen** were the first black military aviators in the U.S. Army Air Corps (AAC), a precursor of the U.S. Air Force. Trained at the *Tuskegee Army Air Field* in Alabama, they flew more than 15,000 individual sorties in Europe and North Africa during World War II.

Six Triple Eight

Advocates had pushed the military to offer African American women some meaningful roles in the war, so commanders sent the **Six Triple Eight** to clear the backlog. They dodged German subs on the way over.

They worked in long underwear and overcoats in cold, dark warehouses in Birmingham, Roen, and Paris. "When they showed us piles and piles of mail and boxes coming apart, it was something else," said Cpl. Martin. But they cleared it in three months, instead of the predicted six. Cpl. Martin turned 97 in May 2019.

They were the only battalion of black women deployed during WWII. Now, they're finally received the recognition they always deserved.

For years after they became the only battalion of African American women to deploy overseas during World War II, the National Memorial Day Parade honored the troops in May 2019.

Happy Valentine's Day Recipe

Ingredients:

Parchment Paper	3 Tbsp. Sifted Cocoa
6 Egg Whites	1 tsp. Cayenne Pepper
1 Tbsp. Cream of Tartar	4 Cups Whipped Cream
1 1/4 Cup Sugar	

1. To make the cake: Heat oven to 200 degrees F. Line two baking pans with parchment paper and set aside. Draw two 9-inch circles in the center of the paper and set aside.
2. Beat egg whites and cream of tartar until foamy. Stream in 1 1/4 cups sugar and continue to beat on high speed. Just as the whites reach their peaks, sprinkle in sifted cocoa and cayenne pepper and continue beating to stiff peaks.
3. Spread the meringue within the circles. Bake for 3 hours, turn off oven, and let sit for 1 hour.
4. Cool the pan on a wire rack. Store in a very dry, cool place.
5. Fill the layers with whipped cream and serve within 2 hours.

NOTE: Use two large spoons — one to cut and the other to scoop — makes serving this cake simple.
