We will be asking Tom to drive for some of our local trips during the upcoming months.

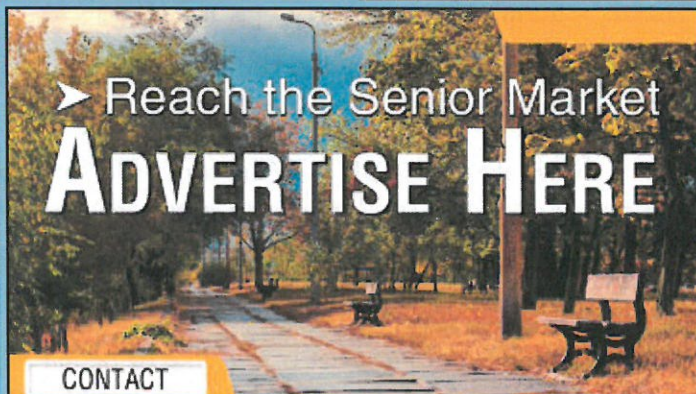
Tom joins Bill Brennan who has been with us for several years and they will both be available when needed.

### *IRISH POTATO SOUP*

#### Ingredients

2 Tbls. Butter	2 Cups plus 3 Tbls. Water, divided
1 Small Onion	1 Tsp. Worcestershire Sauce
1 Celery Stick	1/4 Tsp. Dried Thyme
6 Potatoes, peeled & Diced	1/4 Tsp. Black Pepper
2 (10 1/2 oz.) cans condensed chicken broth	2 Tbls. Cornstarch


#### WHAT TO DO

1. In a soup pot, melt butter over medium heat and saute onion & celery 3 to 4 minutes, or until tender.
2. Add potatoes, broth, 2 cups water, Worcestershire sauce, thyme, and pepper; mix well. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat then reduce heat to low and simmer 35 minutes.
3. In a small bowl, combine remaining 3 Tbls. Water and cornstarch until thickened.

**NOTE:** If you'd like, top with thin slices of hard-boiled eggs and sprinkle with chopped fresh parsley just before serving.

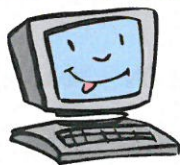

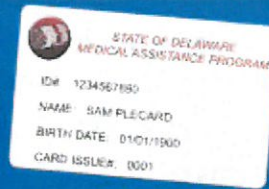


## Health Care Transport Program

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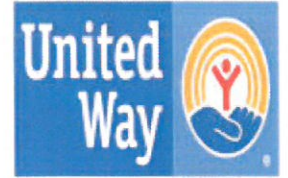
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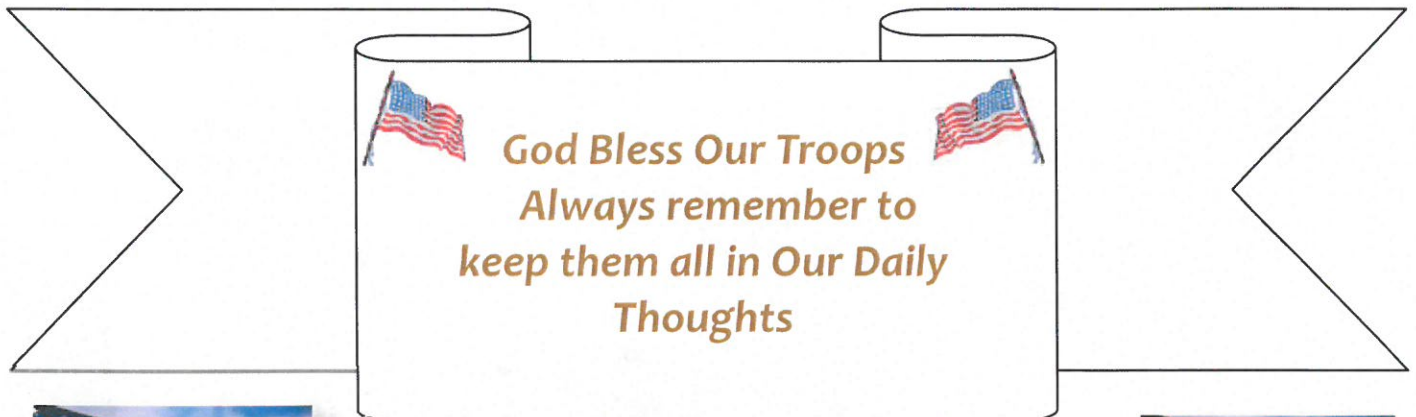
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
