IRISH POTA TO SOUP

Ingredients

2 Tbls. Butter
1 Small Onion
1 Celery Stick
6 Potatoes, peeled & Diced
2 (10 1/2 oz.) cans condensed

chicken broth

2 Cups plus 3 Tbls. Water, divided 1 Tsp. Worcestershire Sauce 1/4 Tsp. Dried Thyme 1/4 Tsp. Black Pepper 2 Tbls. Cornstarch

WHAT TO DO

- In a soup pot, melt butter over medium heat and saute onion & celery 3 to 4 minutes, or until tender.
- Add potatoes, broth, 2 cups water, Worcestershire sauce, thyme, and pepper; mix well. Bring to a boil over mediumhigh heat then reduce heat to low and simmer 35 minutes.
- 3. In a small bowl, combine remaining 3 Tbls. Water and cornstarch until thickened.

<u>NOTE</u>: If you'd like, top with thin slices of hard-boiled eggs and sprinkle with chopped fresh parsley just before serving.


