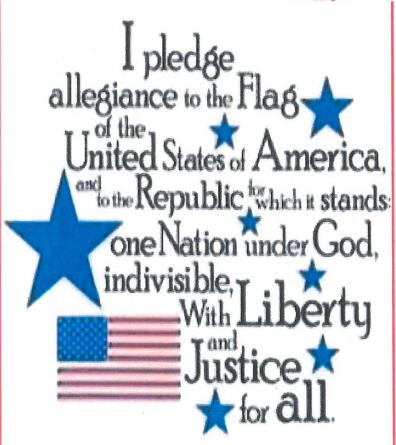

Summer of 2020 is upon us, but the Harvest Years, unfortunately, is still not in full swing. We are continuing our lunch delivery service, our shopping program and our medical appointment programs. Please give us a call as early as you can, even a day or two ahead, to insure that you will be serviced. It is our pleasure to provide this service to you. Please call or contact us if you should be in need of any of the services.

As you may already know, the Governor has put a hold on Phase 3 of our reopening process due to Covid-19, originally scheduled for June 29th. This Phase addressed opening Senior Centers, including congregating meal sites at some capacity. The Division of Services for Aging and Adults with Physical Disabilities, collaborating with the senior centers in the state, drafted reopening guidelines that were submitted to the Division of Health for review. However, there is currently no tentative date set for reopening.

I realize that this is disappointing news for all of us. I do believe that this decision does have the best interest of our senior population in mind. As always, I will share with you any updates as we receive them.

A huge thanks go to our Harvest Years staff for all of their hard work and effort over the past three months. They have been invaluable in keeping our center safe as well as the members that we have been able to service. Moving forward, I feel confident that this extra time in a holding pattern will afford us the time to continue to disinfect, sanitize and organize our facility so that we will better be able to meet the new norms of what a reopening would look like.
