The City of Harrington will have their annual Harrington Christmas Parade, on Friday, December 4, at 7:00pm. This is a traditional nighttime Christmas Parade filled with decorative floats. This year's theme is "Christmas Through a Child's Eyes".

If you are into heritage and history, there are a couple of events going on. The staff of the John Dickinson Mansion is planning A Holiday Gathering At The Mansion throughout December. The Mansion is located at 340 Kitts Hummock Rd, Dover, DE. The re-creation of an 18th century holiday celebration with a Decorative Dessert Table Display is sure to start your holiday right.

The Delaware Agricultural Museum & Village is hosting A Farmer's Christmas from November 27 through December 19. This event features a decorative holiday themed village, artisan demonstrations (weekends only), live musical performances, specialty decorating contest, craft kits for kids (or the kid in us), and more.

The Biggs Museum of American Art is hosting a Winter Wreath Making Workshop on Saturday, December 5, from 10am – 12noon. Please register online for this event.

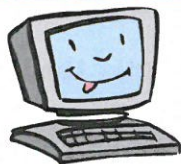
