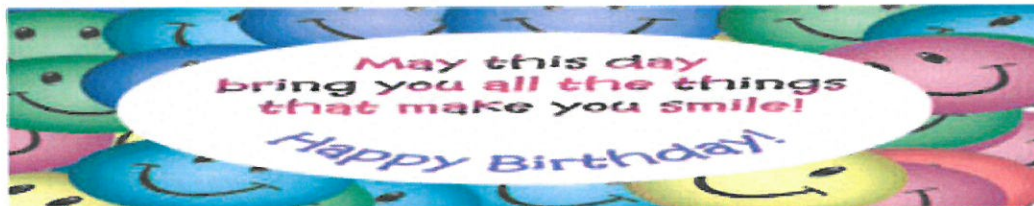

A CLOSER LOOK at How COVID-19 mRNA Vaccines Work



COVID-19 mRNA vaccines give instructions for our cells to make a harmless pieces of what is called the "spike protein."

The spike protein is found on the surface of the virus that causes COVID-19.

COVID-19 mRNA vaccines are given in the upper arm muscle. Once the instructions (mRNA) are inside the muscle cells, the cells use them to make the protein piece. After the protein piece is made, the cell breaks down the instructions and gets rid of them.

Next, the cell displays the protein piece on its surface. Our immune systems recognize that the protein doesn't belong there and begin building an immune response and making antibodies, like what happens in natural infection against COVID-19.

At the end of the process, our bodies have learned how to protect against future infection. The benefit of mRNA vaccines, like all vaccines, is those vaccine gain this protection without ever having to risk the serious consequences of getting sick with COVID-19.

JANUARY 2021 REPORT

GEORGE "JODY" SWEENEY, KENT COUNTY LEVY COURT COMMISSIONER, 5th DISTRICT

Kent County offers many services for those who live here: zoning, planning, streetlights, trash pick-up, and wastewater removal, just to name a few. But there is one that Kent County offers that I hope you never see personally, or never use. That is the Paramedic Service.

KENT COUNTY PARAMEDICS

All 9-1-1 calls come into our Kent County Dispatch Center. Depending on answers to questions from the Dispatcher, you may be transferred to a local police agency or State Police Dispatcher. Two systems, Smart 9-1-1 and RAVE, track the location of incoming calls and identify exactly where the call is coming from. This allows the dispatcher to start emergency vehicles to your location even before you finish answering their questions.

Our County paramedics have all been trained as medical technicians as a requirement of the job. I had the opportunity to ride along with them a few years ago on emergency calls and have had them visit my dad and Father-in-Law on multiple emergencies. Under extreme circumstances, they treat all involved with the greatest respect.

Your 9-1-1 Center takes in approximately 100,000 calls per year. About one-third of those calls are for EMS or Fire calls. For EMS, those are the volunteer fire company individuals that will arrive in mere minutes for non-life threatening emergencies. But when the call is for life threatening emergencies, the Advanced Life Support (ALS) vehicles from Kent County are dispatched. The ALS unit has all of the equipment to sustain life until the victim can be transported to a local emergency room.

When activated, they leave their station in less than three minutes, arriving on the scene in approximately ten minutes, anywhere in Kent County. Those stations are strategically located in Central Dover near Winner Ford, Harrington Volunteer Fire Company, Frederica Volunteer Fire Company, the Wheatley's Pond Paramedic Station, and soon the new West Dover Paramedic Station, to be completed in late 2021.




The new West Dover paramedic Station will be manned 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Kent County had an opportunity to acquire an abandoned building in a key location on a major road that will allow Paramedic units to avoid the traffic conditions of Dover and the possibility for a passing train, to arrive on scene in locations west of Dover.

But emergency calls are not all our Paramedics do. You can see them at most events such as the Delaware State Fair, Firefly, Dover Downs races, parades, festivals, and bike tours. Our units participate in police actions such as hostage or barricaded situations, raids, and other police emergencies where injuries could be imminent. They train with local and State Police and the Dover Air Force Base for all levels of regional or HAZMAT emergencies. Whether on bike, golf cart, or the white and blue Paramedic Power Unit, they are equipped to handle any emergency.

Kent County takes great pride in our Emergency Management Department, Dispatch system, and our Paramedics. When lives are at stake, these are the men and women I want there first.

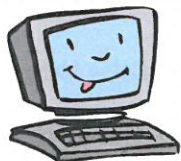

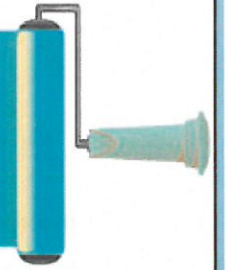

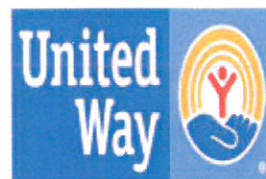
