#### February is Black History Month in USA and Canada. In the UK, it is Celebrated in October

Black History Month got its start in 1926 when Dr. Carter G. Woodson, an African American, promoted Negro History Week in February. The time was selected because it included the birthdays of Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln which had been notable dates for the black community since the start of the twentieth century. Also known as African-American History Month, it was first observed by students and faculty at Kent State University in 1970. In 1976 it evolved into a month-long celebration in 1976 and became a national holiday when President Gerald Ford recognized "the too-often neglected accomplishments of black Americans in every area of endeavor throughout our history" in a speech to mark the United States Bicentennial. It is a time for all Americans to reflect on both the history and teachings of African Americans, and to focus on the progress, richness and diversity of African American achievements. Black History Month has no overall coordinating body - anybody can organize an event. Consequently, every year sees an eclectic mix - from historical walks to seminars - organized by, for example, local authorities, schools, and voluntary organizations. Today Black History Month is celebrated not only in the US, but around the globe by five different countries.

#### **Senior Center Transportation Disbursement**

Were you aware that Senior Center Transportation Services are funded through donations, very minimal fees, and hundreds of thousands of dollars passed through Kent County Levy Court from the Delaware Transit Corporation (DTC).

Each year, for the last 18 years, DTC provides funds and authorizes Kent County to divide those funds to senior centers for the transportation of seniors and members from home to shopping, doctors' appointments, and to their respective senior centers. Each Senior Center can structure their programs to suit the needs of their members, so some have one or maybe two vans, maybe a bus or two, or maybe even a fleet of buses.

To make this distribution fair, each of the six senior centers in Kent County, as well as the Kent Sussex Industries, are required to submit a budget of their transportation needs. Each budget submission details the Senior Center costs for their transportation program. They provide costs like fuel and vehicle service, insurance, personnel costs, and any revenue they received to help offset their costs.

Kent County officials, not the elected type, but actual hard-working employees, then compare the budgets and each Senior Center's needs against the funds that are made available. Our Director of Finance Susan Durham and Count Administrator Mike Petit de Mange have been doing this together for many years. They arrive at a recommended distribution to the six senior centers for Levy Court Commissioners to consider. Their recommendation for each senior center was determined by either the FY2020 Actual Expenditures with a 2% Adjustment, or the 3 Year Average Expenditures with a 2% Adjustment, whichever is greater. Whichever method works best for a particular Senior Center is what is used.

This year, a total of \$639,400 was recommended for distribution to the six eligible senior centers in Kent County, with the complement balance going to the Kent-Sussex Industries to assist them with the great work they do in our County with those with disabilities. As requested by DTC, the \$50,000 additional allocation for Modem Maturity Center is included in the \$647,438 recommended distribution.

So the next time you need a ride, or you happen to be on the way to your doctor on your local Senior Center's bus or van, remember this: The Delaware Transit Corporation and Kent County Levy Court work together to make sure that the ride is either free or a very low cost. We understand that many of you live on limited income and we work hard to make sure that there are no extra costs that affect your quality of life.






