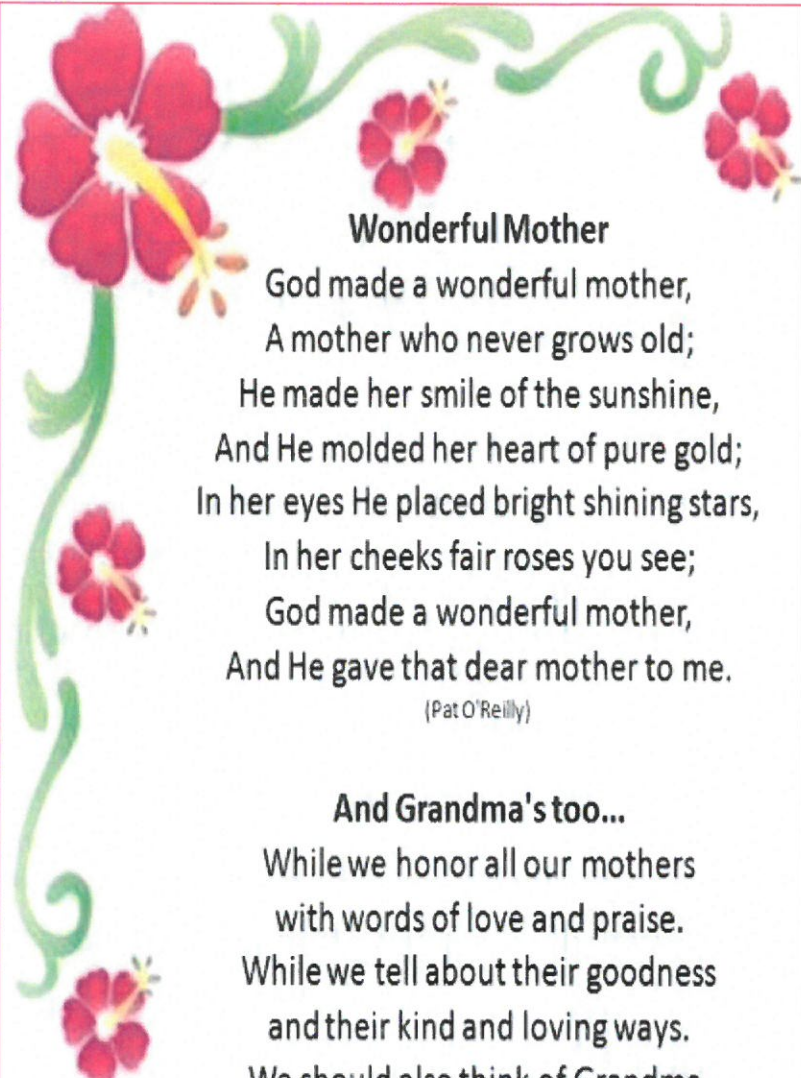

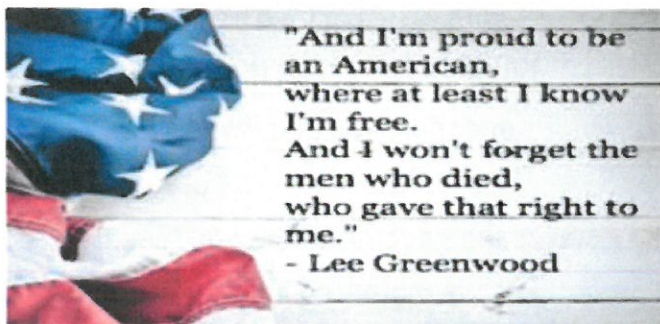

The greatest gift of all is to be able to spend precious time with your family on such a special day. Breakfast in bed, along with a bouquet of flowers, would be a nice way to start the day.

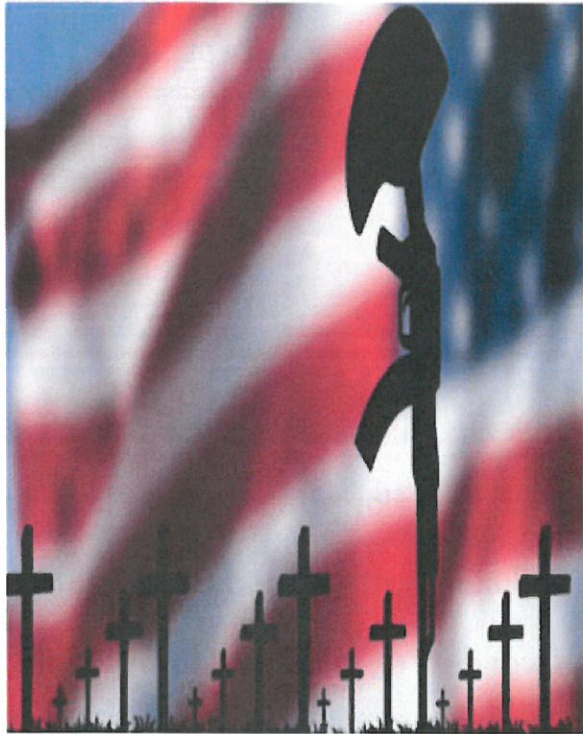

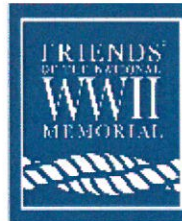

MAY 2021 REPORT

Kent County Annual Budget

On April 27, 2021, Kent County Levy Court Commissioners will be voting on the Annual Operating and Capital Budgets and Tax Rates. This is always a busy time for County employees involved in the budget process, as well as Commissioners who are diligent about protecting your tax dollars.

This year, as it has been for the past 12 years, there will be no increase in taxes. In fact, in Kent County, there has only been one tax increase in more than 35 years. If you consider that Kent County is impacted by the Consumer Price Index for purchases, increasing health care costs and salaries for our employees, the fact that the only property tax increase came as a result of Dog Control costs imposed in 2009 is an amazing feat. I wish it could continue the same for many more years, but you just never know what will happen.

Kent County actually approves two budgets; the General Budget and the Sewer Budget. The Sewer Budget is an "enterprise" budget, meaning that all revenue received can only be spent toward maintaining the sewer system in the County. The General Budget is everything else.

Kent County receives revenue from multiple sources. Of course, the largest source of revenue is property taxes, which is about 35% of all County revenue. Other major sources of revenue are fees from provided services, such as permits, processing wills, sheriff sales, using our Deeds Recordation, Clerk of the Peace Marriage, among others. We also receive revenue from other taxes, such as the Library Reciprocal Borrowing Tax and Suburban Tax Districts. Additional revenue comes from grants and transfer sources.

The General Budget also receives revenue for trash districts and streetlight districts. The revenue collected for those funds must match the cost to provide that service to the distinct districts that have agreed to use those services.

County expenses are typical of most government budgets. About 74% is for personnel expenses, including salaries, healthcare, and pension contributions. About 5.44% of this year's budget goes toward capital projects, 4.69% goes toward operating expenses, and 4.94% towards Grants and Programs. Of note is that only about 2.25% goes toward debt service, which is very low, meaning the County does not borrow money; we stay within our means.

Another great aspect of our budget is the Grants and Programs. This year, we are increasing grants to Kent County Volunteer Fire Companies to \$1 million dollars. We also continue to provide grant funding to municipal heritage programs for parades and town festivals. Senior centers in Kent County are extremely important for the services they provide from meals to healthy living and entertainment programs, so that funding will continue this year as well.

The Capital Budget for this coming year consists of vehicle replacements and technology upgrades among others. But the biggest capital projects continue to support our Public Safety services with new 9-1-1 consoles, cardiac monitor equipment for our Paramedic vehicles, and the new West Dover Paramedic Station on West Forrest Avenue.

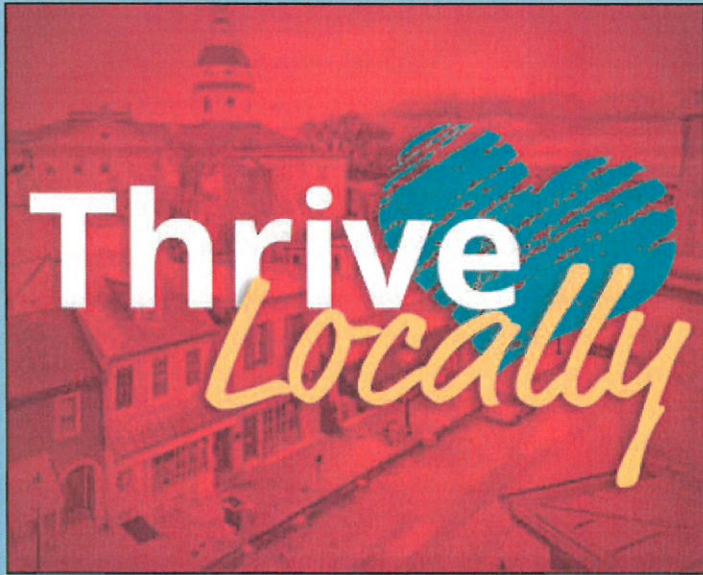

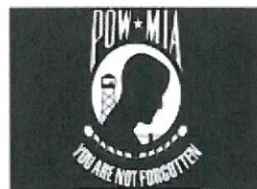
