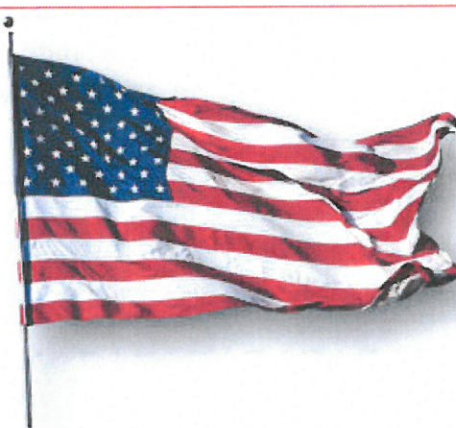

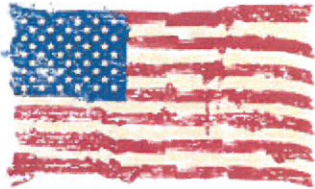

WHAT IS FLAG DAY?

When the **American Revolution** broke out in 1775, the colonists weren't fighting united under a single flag. Instead, most regiments participating in the war for independence against the British fought under their own flags. In June of 1775, the **Second Continental Congress** met in Philadelphia to create the Continental Army—a unified colonial fighting force—with the hopes of more organized battle against its colonial oppressors. This led to the creation of what was, essentially, the first “American” flag, the

For some, this flag, which was comprised of 13 red and white alternating stripes and a Union Jack in the corner, was too similar to that of the British. **George Washington** soon realized that flying a flag that was even remotely close to the British flag was not a great confidence-builder for the revolutionary effort, so he turned his efforts towards creating a new symbol of freedom for the soon-to-be fledgling nation.

On June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress took a break from writing the **Articles of Confederation** and passed a resolution stating that “the flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white,” and that “the union be 13 stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation.”

Over 100 years later, in 1916, **President Woodrow Wilson** marked the anniversary of that decree by officially establishing **June 14th as Flag Day**.

JUNE 2021 REPORT

This morning, I am waking from our first night camping in our new-to-us camper. My wife, Crystal, and I decided that we needed to spend time away from the hustle and bustle of our jobs. We had three choices: a boat, a beach house, or an RV. We chose the RV, a 32 foot, Jayco motorhome.

After purchasing from a family friend, our first ride was to a local gas station to fill it up. After the gas pump clicked off, I handed the receipt to my wife as I always do. The look on her face was, "Oh what have we done?" Then, I dropped the bomb, this was just the first receipt, I will have the second one in a few minutes.

The next thing we had to do was take out our new RV for a shakedown cruise. But where to go? In Kent County, there are not many campgrounds to choose from.

Killens Pond Family Campground is the only state park in Kent County to offer camping. Started as a mill pond in the 1700's, Killens Pond was established as a state park in 1965. The campground came much later, but other features such as Hiking, Fishing, Boating, Swimming, Canoeing, Nature Programs, Disc Golf, Geocaching, Picnicking, and Horseshoe pits were added to attract daytime visits. Killens Pond is within driving distance of the Harrington State Fair Grounds, Dover Downs Racetrack and Casino, the DE Turf Sports Recreation Facility, John Dickinson Plantation, and the Prime Hook National Wildlife Refuge. It is also only about 45 miles from two ranked best beaches on the East Coast, Rehoboth Beach and Dewey Beach. For campers, Killens Pond will accommodate everything from tents to motorhomes like our and bigger. There are even cabins you can rent, but make your plans well in advance, as they book quickly during the summer months.

We looked at Killens as our first choice for our shakedown cruise. As a very popular park, it was booked for every weekend that we tried. The race was in town for one of those weekends, but all sites that would accommodate our behemoth were booked. We ended up a Tuckahoe State Park near Queen Anne, MD. As far as campgrounds go, it is very similar to Killens Pond in that the campsites are roomy, and distant from your neighbors. We have electric hookup, but that is really all we need.

Other State Park campgrounds in Delaware are worth a look, and offer many of the same amenities as Killens Pond. To the north near Newark is Lums Pond State Park. To the south near the beaches are Cape Henlopen State Park and Delaware Seashore State Park. If the beach is not your thing, Trap Pond State Park near Laurel has some great nature trails and boating options.

Our next trip is to San Antonio, Texas to visit our daughter. After this weekend at Tuckahoe State Park, I can't wait to hit the road again to see America from the ground instead of from seven miles high.

D-Day Invasion – June 6, 1944

This battle is often referred to as the “Longest Day”. D-Day marks the beginning of the invasion of German occupied Western Europe. Codenamed “Operation Overlord,” the battle began with the largest amphibious assault in history, as the Allies landed 24,000 men on the beaches of Normandy. In just the first day of intense combat, 4,414 men were killed and 6,000 were wounded. The D-Day landings marked the start of a long and costly campaign in north-west Europe, which ultimately convinced the German high command that defeat was inevitable.

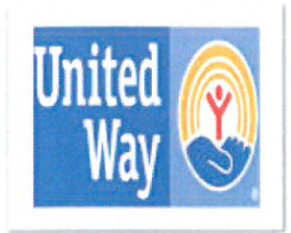

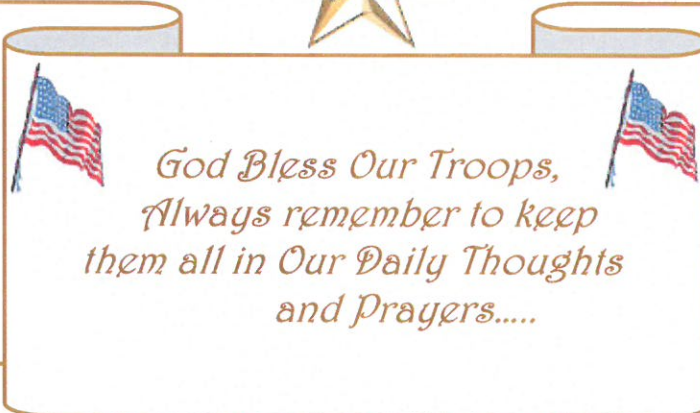
