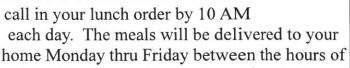

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

12 thin slices top round beef 3/4 teaspoon salt, divided 3/4 teaspoon black pepper, divided 3/4 cup finely chopped onion, divided 3/4 cup finely chopped bread & butter pickles 1/2 pound raw bacon, diced, divided 3 Tablespoons vegetable oil 2 cups beef broth 1/4 cup all-purpose flour 1/3 cup water

## GERMAN ROULADEN

#### WHAT TO DO:

- 1. Lay beef slices on a flat surface; sprinkle evenly with 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/2 teaspoon pepper.
- 2. Sprinkle about 1 Tablespoon each of onion, pickles, and raw bacon on each slice of beef. Roll up meat tightly and secure with a toothpick.
- 3. In a large pot over medium-high heat, heat oil. Place meat rolls in pot and sauté until browned on all sides. Add remaining broth and bring to a boil. Reduce heat to low, cover, and simmer 50-55 minutes or until beef is fork tender.
- 4. Remove beef to a platter and remove toothpicks. Cover and set aside.
- 5. In a small bowl, whisk flour and water. Pour mixture into pot and stir constantly until thickened. Stir in remaining salt and pepper. Pour gravy over beef and serve immediately.
- 6. Serve with noodles, rice or spätzle's.
- 7. Serve with an ice cold German Brew.

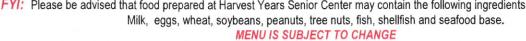

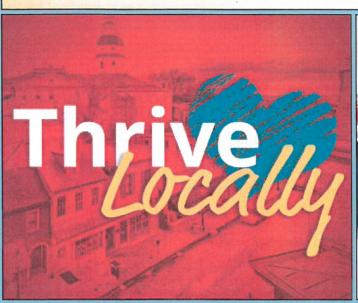

# Grandmother's Honey Cake

#### What You'll Need:

- 1 Cup Honey
- 2 teaspoons Baking Soda
- 1/2 Cup Vegetable Oil
- 1 teaspoon Vanilla Extract
- 1 Cup Sugar
- 1 Cup Brewed Coffee

1/4 Cup Red Wine

- 3 /4 Cup All-Purpose Flour
- 1 teaspoon Cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon Ground Nutmeg
- 1 teaspoon Ground Cloves
- 1/4 teaspoon Salt

#### What To Do:

- 1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. Coat two 4 x 8 inch loaf pans with cooking spray.
- 2. In a small bowl, combine honey & baking soda; mix well and set aside.
- 3. In a large bowl, beat eggs, oil, vanilla, and sugar. Add coffee and wine; mix well. Add remaining ingredients and the honey mixture and beat until thoroughly combined. Pour into loaf pans.
- 4. Bake 60-65 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool on wire rack.

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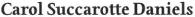
