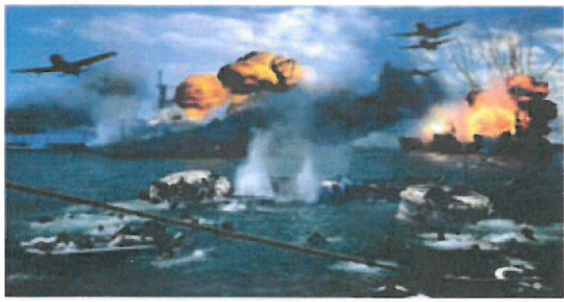

PEARL HARBOR

December 7, 1941

Known as a
“date that would live in infamy”

On **December 7, 1941**, the Japanese attacked the Pearl Harbor Naval base just before 8 AM Hawaiian time. The attack took America by surprise, and crippled or destroyed nearly 20 American ships and more than 300 airplanes. Most importantly, the attack killed more than 2,400 naval and military personnel including 68 civilians.

The next day, **President Franklin D. Roosevelt** addressed Congress and the nation with a somber yet stirring speech in which he swore that America would never forget December 7th, 1941, as a **“date that would live in infamy.”**

Celebration Punch

Your party guests will be pleased as punch when they get a sip of our refreshing *Celebration Punch*. In a large punch bowl stir this one together easily with your favorite bottle of bubbly and some convenient ingredients from the market freezer case.

What You'll Need

- 1 (12-ounce) can frozen fruit punch drink concentrate, thawed
- 1 (6-ounce) can frozen orange juice concentrate, thawed
- 1 (6-ounce) can frozen lemonade concentrate, thawed
- 2 (750-ml) bottles champagne (see Notes)
- 1 quart orange sherbet

What to Do

1. In a large punch bowl, combine the fruit punch, orange juice and lemonade concentrates. Stir until well combined. Serve immediately, or cover and chill until ready to —
2. Just before serving, stir in the champagne and orange sherbet.

Note: If you prefer a nonalcoholic version, substitute 2 liters of ginger ale for the champagne. For a festive look, slice up a few frozen oranges, lemons and/or limes to float on top of the punch.

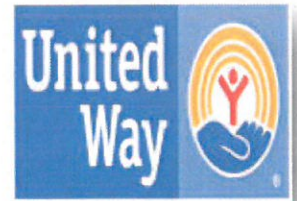
