What is Passover?

The eight-day Jewish holiday of Passover is celebrated in the early spring from the 15th through the 22nd of the Hebrew month of Nissan. Passover (**Pesach**) commemorates the emancipation of the Israelites from slavery in ancient Egypt. **Pesach** is observed by avoiding leaven, and highlighted by the **Seder** meals that include four cups of wine, eating matzah and bitter herbs, and retelling the story of the Exodus.

In Hebrew it is known as **Pesach** (which means "to pass over"), because G-d passed over the Jewish homes when killing the Egyptian first born on the very first Passover eve.

History: Harvest Years Senior Center was founded in 1977 by a group of ladies who believed that a Senior Center should be a service organization first and a social/recreational organization second. For many years, Harvest Years membership met in a church basement on Bradford Street in Dover. After several successful fundraisers and grants from the county, Harvest Years was able to buy property on Walker Road which was subsequently used in a land swap for its new location on Saulsbury Road in Dover. A comprehensive array of social, recreational, educational, artistic and cultural activities were offered to our members. A hot, nutritious lunch was prepared on-site. Outreach and support services were made available to members. Off-site and overnight trips were also part of the program. A monthly newsletter was published and mailed to the membership. Our shopping program enabled seniors, residing in Kent County, Delaware, to enroll in this program. Eligible seniors who were essentially homebound and did not have the resources were enrolled in this service. Harvest Years employed a staff of shoppers to shop for these eligible seniors in order to maintain their independence in their community.

New Location: Our membership was rapidly growing and our Board of Directors and members decided that we needed a larger building. In 2005 we were proud to hold a Grand Opening Ceremony of a brand new building located at 30 South Street in Camden. We are currently serving our community from this location.

Present Day 2022: Harvest Years continues to follow our *Motto* of “*Seniors Helping Seniors*”. We strive to continue with programs and services that enable our senior members to enjoy their lives through social and recreational and educational activities. Our Shopping Program and Medical Transport Service Program continues to help our homebound senior members to maintain their independence. Hot lunches are served daily in-house and additionally meals are delivered to those who prefer to stay eat at home. Many fun daily activities are provided, including exercise classes. Day trips are provided for those who like to enjoy a day out at a show and a restaurant. *Our Mission of Achieving Fulfillment through Services, Meals, and Activities will continue as we continue serving our community.*

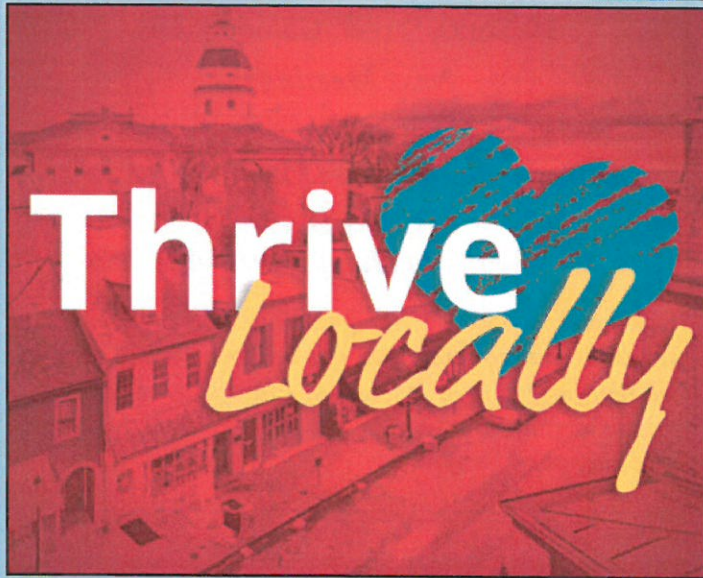
