SEPTEMBER 2022 REPORT

Did you know, that libraries are one of the best resources for entertainment you can get, and that it's free? British author Angela Clarke said, "A Library is not just a reference service: It is a place for the vulnerable.... Libraries are a haven in a world where community services are being ground down to nothing. Libraries are vital. Their worth cannot be measured in books alone."

Kent County has a handful of municipal libraries, along with many Leave-A-Book, Get-A-Book locations: Harrington, Dover, and Smyrna libraries receive most of their funding through municipal funds that residents pay tax into. Milford receives most of their funding through a Milford District Library Tax. The Kent County Public Library is mostly funded through Kent County general funds. Some libraries, like the one in Felton, have donations and volunteers. There are other sources of funds, such as Delaware Library grants, federal grants, and, most importantly to those who do not live in one of the aforementioned cities, the Library Reciprocal Tax.

Many years ago, a couple of the cities mentioned allowed only those who lived in their cities to borrow materials and to use the libraries freely. If you lived outside those cities, you had to purchase a library card to borrow books. The County worked with those libraries and developed a system to allow all Kent Countians to access library materials from any library. It is called the Reciprocal Borrowing Tax. Since 1995, Kent County has provided more than \$13million in funding to the four municipal libraries, not including the Kent County Public Library. Only those residents in unincorporated areas, outside of municipal boundaries where city taxes pay for libraries, have this tax on their annual Real Estate Property Tax bill.

Libraries keep track of those books that are borrowed using library cards of those who don't live in their towns. The County reimburses those libraries for those borrowings. The last few years have resulted in a downturn in borrowings from libraries, leaving an excess in the County Library Reciprocal Tax fund. As we have done in the past, Levy Court Commissioners voted to provide an equal share of grants to libraries for improving library services.

The internet is not a replacement for libraries. Libraries will not fail you. I encourage you: Get a library card. Visit your library. Decide for yourself. Books, movies, newspapers, magazines, computers, job programs, children's crafts, music, and much, much more, are available.

And finally, CONGRATULATIONS to Delaware's own Dr. Annie Norman, State Librarian / Director of the Delaware Division of Libraries. Dr. Norman was recently appointed by President Joe Biden to the National Museum and Library Services Board. After many years guiding library services here in Delaware, and hopefully many more, Dr. Norman will now participate in providing advice on general policies with respect to the duties, powers, and authority of the Institute of Museum and Library Services. In addition, she will participate in the annual selection of National Medals recipients. Again, *CONGRATULATIONS Annie!*




