The holiday season is upon us. This past year has been one of the most stressful of political seasons, especially if you are like me and read as much as you can on what is going on across our nation. But that is over now, finally!

Now it is time to move away from politics, and enjoy family, if even for a short time. There is so much to offer here in Kent County and Delaware for families.

Hudson Fields near Milton will again host their drive through Christmas decorations, called "Winter Wonder-Fest". The cost is as little as \$20 for a car full of your kids or grandkids. The little kids in all of us love the lights and scenes of Christmas over the years. You can also enjoy the lights on a good, old-fashioned hayride through the lights. So take the kids, or grandkids, and start your season off right with some Christmas Joy! All ticket sales go to local Sussex County charities. Over the last six years, more than 300,000 guests riding through the decorations have helped to contribute more than \$850,000 in funds to local charities and other community events. Tickets can be bought online at WONDERFESTDE.ORG, or at the gate. The event starts on November 18 and runs through December 31.

If you are in Kent County and dread the ride down to Milton, this year, The Woodlands at Dover Motor Speedway is hosting its own drive-thru light display to bring in the Holiday Cheer. Called the "Gift of Lights at Dover Motor Speedway", this event runs from Thanksgiving through December 31, and features more than 3,000,000 lights and more than 60 displays over a 1.5 mile course. You can buy tickets and check out the calendar for special event nights, like First Responders Night or Delaware Food Bank, at GiftOfLightsDover.com. Tickets are \$35 per car. The Woodlands is also the scene of the annual Firefly Music Festival.

If short drives aren't your thing, and you are looking for a longer drive, try the "Delaware Christmas Lights Road Trip". This is a 132 mile drive starting in Wilmington and ending in Rehoboth Beach, will take you to see nine different homes, businesses, and towns that are decorated for the holidays. From the Smith Lights on The Hill and the Wilmington and Western Railroad in New Castle to the Apple Electric Lightshow in Rehoboth Beach, there is sure to be lights aplenty and a great start to the Christmas Season. Add in The Woodlands to this event and there are more than a billion lights to see.

This season, take some time and put family first. Gather for food, friendship, and fun. The next crazy political season will soon be upon us, so take some time.




