## Tour of Long Island, New York Monday, September 18 - Thursday, September 21, 2023

September 18: We arrive on Long Island and visit the Cradle of Aviation Museum, where we will explore spacecrafts,

hot air balloons and an actual Apollo Lunar Module, as we learn about Long Island's role and why it is called the Cradle of Aviation. We will then check into our hotel where we have accommodations for the next 3 evenings. We are treated to a delicious welcome dinner this evening. (D)

September 19: We board our motorcoach for the drive to Sagamore Hill for a visit to the home – and summer White House – of President Theodore Roosevelt. **September 20:** Following breakfast we drive to downtown Riverhead, Long Island located on the scenic Peconic River. We will visit the Long Island Aquarium where we will see one of the largest all-living coral reef displays, a 120,000-gallon shark tank and much more marine life. We will then see some beautiful art at the Heckscher Museum, where we will explore many art exhibits and see some of Long Island's very own artist's work on display. **September 21:** Before the drive home, we visit Old Westbury Gardens, the elegant estate of financier John Phipps. Built in 1906, the site features a 70 room English manor house and beautiful traditional

formal gardens spread over 100 acres of Long Island's famous North Shore. We then continue our drive home. (B)
