To our Dear Members....

We realize that this is a very difficult and anxious time for everyone, but most especially for older Delawareans who are in a much higher risk category for contracting the Coronavirus, COVID-19.

Here is what we do know: The State, working with all of its individual community partners, and the public are putting precautions in place to **flatten the curve**, or lesson the spread of this virus. The COVID-19 Virus has major implications on our most vulnerable population - our seniors, those with underlying health conditions, and those that are immunocompromised.

Seniors, in those high risk groups have been advised by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to avoid crowds to any extent possible and to maintain social distancing when you must go out.

Seniors who believe they may have symptoms of COVID-19, which includes fever and a cough, or shortness of breath, should contact their Primary Care Physician. If you do not have a Primary Care Physician, you should contact your health insurance company for further directives.

Having said all of that, this is what the Harvest Years has been and will continue to do, until we are no longer able to do so:

As of **MARCH 17th**, our Center's facility has been closed to all senior activities until further notice. However, if you need a meal, or any other service, **please call us at 302 698-4285**. Staff members and volunteers are available to assist you between 8 AM and 2 PM. Our Soup to Go services, Shopping and Medical Transportation Program will continue on a limited basis.
