We realize that this is a very difficult and anxious time for everyone, but most especially for older Delawareans who are in a much higher risk category for contracting the Coronavirus, COVID-19.

Here is what we do know: The State, working with all of its individual community partners, and the public are putting precautions in place to *flatten the curve*, or lesson the spread of this virus. The COVID-19 Virus has major implications on our most vulnerable population - our seniors, those with underlying health conditions, and those that are immunocompromised.

Seniors, in those high risk groups have been advised by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to avoid crowds to any extent possible and to maintain social distancing when you must go out.




