Safe travels to all who are visiting family and friends during these summer months. Please reach out to us if you should need anything.



JULY 2023 REPORT

March is "In like a lion, out like a lamb". April is "April showers bring May flowers". May is the start of a "May-December" relationship. May is also the month of the year where allergy sufferers experience the worst in environmental impact. Pollen. The pollen that we all see covering our cars is often the cause of sneezing, runny noses, and watery eyes. And while it is a burden to those with allergies, without it, we would not survive as a species.

Pollen, according to KIDSHEALTH.ORG, is a "fine powder produced by certain plants. During the spring, summer, and fall seasons, it is released into the air and picked up by the wind. The wind carries it to other plants so they can make seeds." Without that pollination, plants would not produce fruits and vegetables, nor would they produce seeds for future years' plantings.

Pollination occurs throughout nature by pollen being picked up and carried by the wind, or by birds, bugs, and bees picking it up and carrying it from plant-to-plant. And this mostly occurs in the month of May.

Later this summer, I will be proposing "No Mow May" to the rest of Kent County Levy Court. By instituting a "No Mow May", it promotes pollinators to pollinate our gardens and fields, continuing the process that has been going on for millions, nay billions of years.

If it passes, "No Mow May" does NOT mean that you can't mow your grass. It means that you don't HAVE to mow your grass. And in Kent County, it will mean that the mean ole County Inspectors (who do a great job, by the way) won't be citing anyone who fails to mow their grass. Kent County's grass ordinance is 12". If you allow your grass to grow 12" or higher, and someone complains, an Inspector will cite your property with a 5-day grace period to cut the grass. If you fail to cut the grass upon further inspection of an Inspector, you will be cited in violation and Kent County will have a landscaping contractor cut the grass for you within 30 days. A recent violator had their grass cut for \$175, with a \$50 fine, for a total of \$225. That is pretty extreme for failing to cut your grass.

"No Mow May" will mean that during that month, County Inspectors will focus on other violation complaints, most of which are more extreme or safety related.

Please stay tuned for further developments on "No Mow May". Remember that to pass ordinances or new procedures like this one will require four votes, which is a majority of Levy Court Commissioners.


